In 2010-2015 I worked as a Program Manager at the Embassy of Sweden. Among other things, we provided institutional support to CSOs. This program was based on a unique methodology that supported the overall development of organizations. In addition, the Swedish government allocated funds for less experienced organizations that needed organizational development. We used the innovative Marketplace mechanism, developed by Pact Inc. and implemented by ISAR Ednannia. That's how ISAR Ednannia has become our reliable partner, a team entrusted with the difficult task of selecting, financing and mentoring CSOs who sought to strengthen and develop. More than 130 organizations have taken advantage of these opportunities: some have prepared a strategy, some have improved financial and accounting processes, and some have learned how to design good project proposals and write them in language that donors understand.

Once, I visited ISAR Ednannia together with my colleague, an auditor, to find out how our partners coped with the documentation of the complex work they were performing. We saw a very clean, clear and precise system of internal management, so precise it was almost «surgeon's». 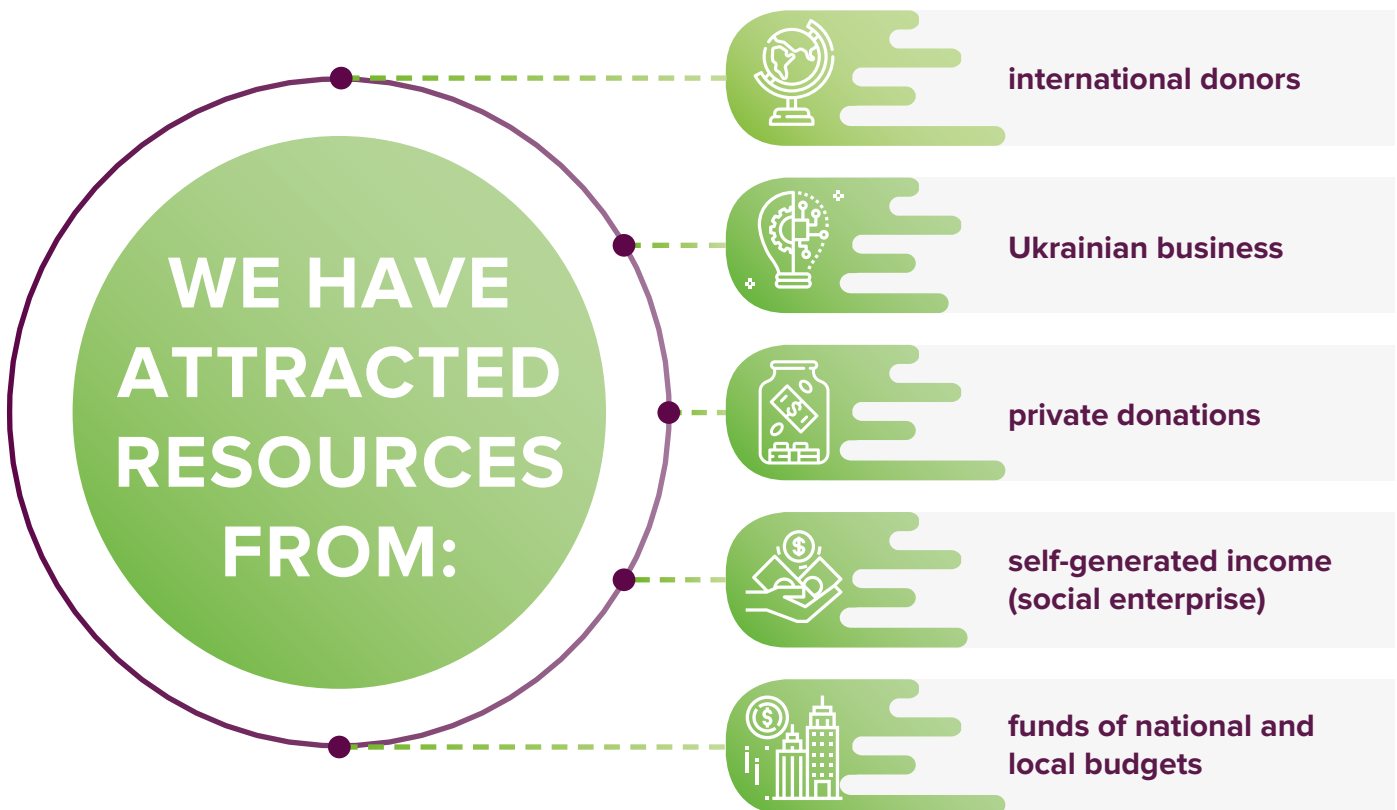

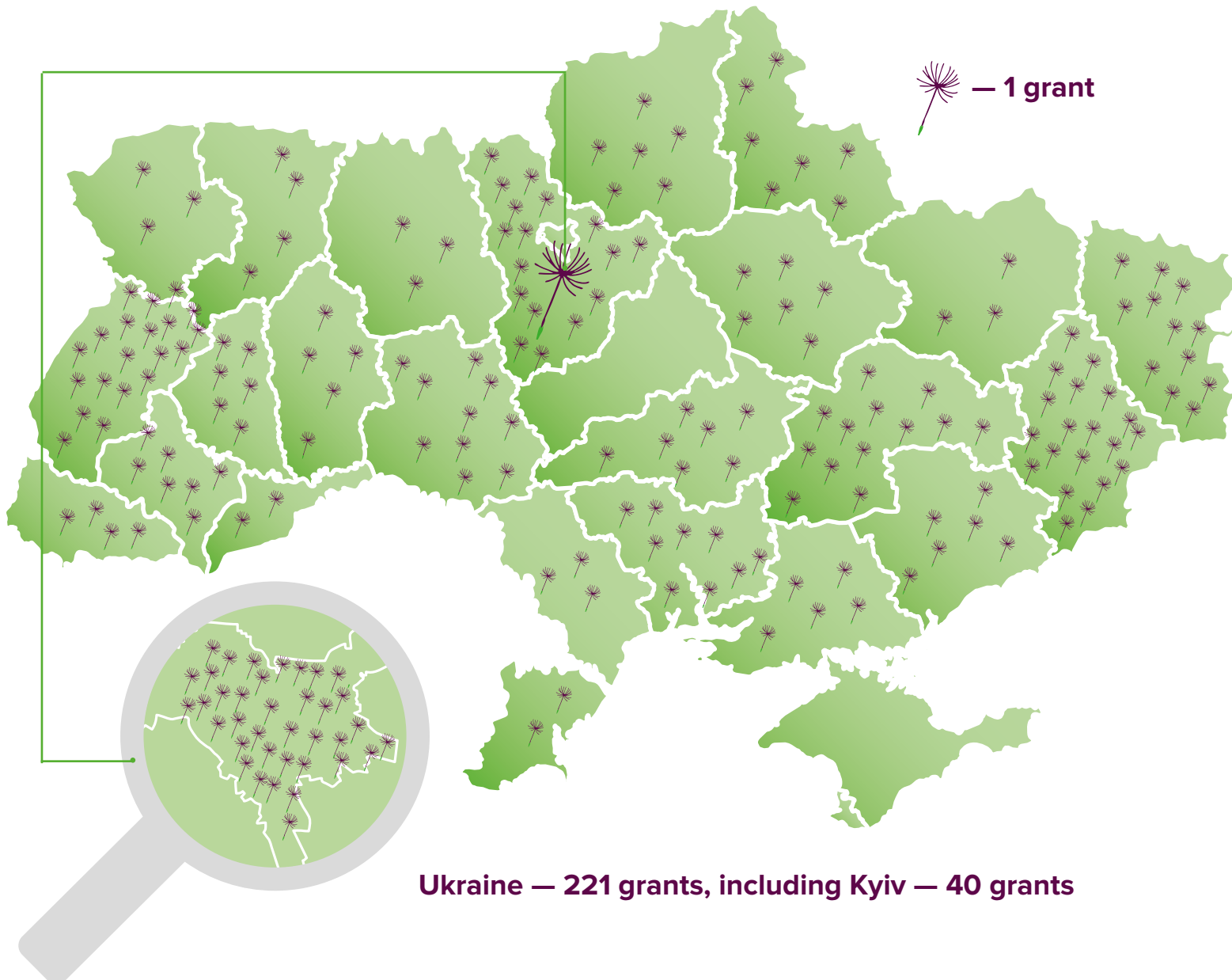

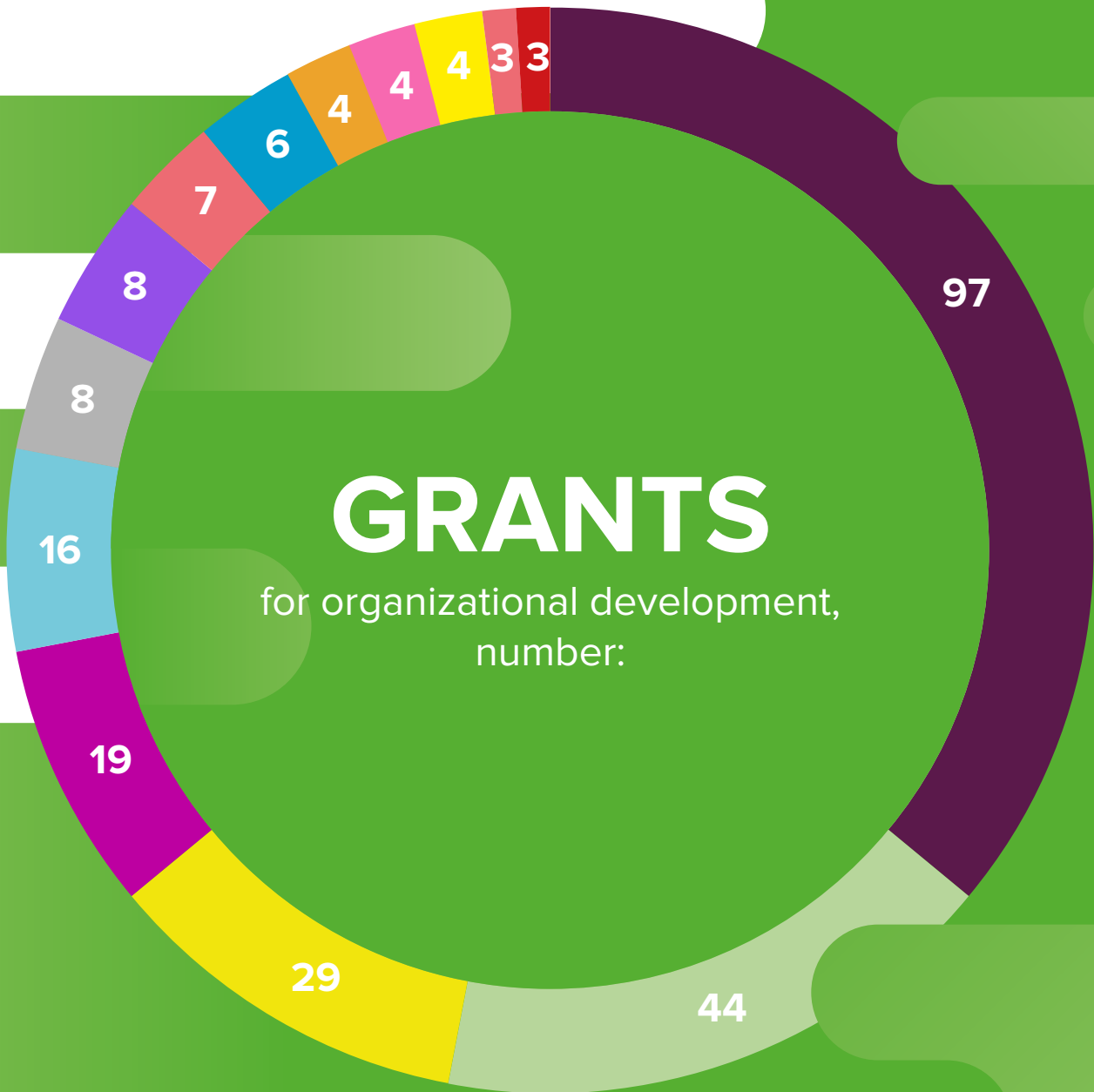

ADVOCACY SCHOOL FOR ORGANIZATIONS WORKING FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

A significant number of organizations working for people with disabilities until recently received funding for their statutory goals from the state budget. This situation is already changing, funding is allocated and will continue to be allocated on a competitive basis for projects or for the provision of social services. We have organized a special Advocacy school in order to prepare organizations that work for people with disabilities for such competitive environment.

It was not easy to find a hotel in Kyiv able to accommodate more than one person on a wheelchair. It is even more difficult to take into account the needs of all participants, so that learning at our School became truly accessible to them. FINANCIAL SURVIVAL CAMP

Three-day symbiosis of theory, practice and exchange of experience of executives and financial managers of civic and charitable organizations — a real “survival camp”! This educational School was designed to strengthen the capacity of CSOs to build a system of financial sustainability. So, the curriculum started with governance, continued with studying the system of financial management and internal policies and procedures, and ended with classical and digital fundraising.

TWO SCHOOLS FOR ORGANIZATIONAL DEVELOPMENT FOR ORGANIZATIONS – NATIONAL PARTNERS OF UNHCR UKRAINE

SCHOOL FOR ORGANIZATIONAL DEVELOPMENT “SMALL GRANTS BIG IMPACT”

The school consisted of trainings aiming to strengthen the capacity of NGOs who were grantees of the small grants program in support of initiatives for strengthening public safety, ensuring respect for human rights and the rule of law in Donetsk, Luhansk and Zhytomyr oblasts (funded by UNDP “Recovery and Peacebuilding” Programme). The most important areas of work of non-profit organizations were covered by this training: communications, governance and management, policies and procedures. The work of the School has ended with a special session on how to draw up documents properly and on donors’ reporting requirements.

EDUCATIONAL CONFERENCE FOR COMMUNITY FOUNDATIONS OF



Community funds are non-governmental organizations that attract community resources and redistribute them on a competitive basis to encourage local initiatives. ISAR Ednannia supports these organizations for many years and provides new opportunities for their education and growth. In 2018, we held an educational conference where representatives of Ukrainian community foundations became acquainted with the concept of SROI as an innovative tool for measuring social impact. Another educational session was conducted by Damian Hutton (UK), who introduced the model of social impact measurement. This session was possible because of the support of UNDP Ukraine. At the end, the participants learned about a new approach to building community security based on the community policing and exchanged their experience of implementing it.



Mentorship

AUNHCR Ukraine promotes the organizational development of its national partners. Since the beginning of the war in eastern Ukraine, these organizations have assumed a significant share of the burden of legal, social, psychological and humanitarian assistance to all who need it. The goal of our cooperation with UNHCR is to strengthen the organizational, technical and adaptive capacities of these organizations and strengthen their capacity for influence.



Considering that these organizations are mostly mature and experienced, have a lot of experience and developed managerial skills, we have chosen a mentoring approach for this work. The group of specialists on organizational development of ISAR Ednannia carries out an external independent assessment of the level of organizational development, which becomes the basis for constructing an individual development plan. Afterwards we work separately with each organization, directing our efforts to meeting their specific needs for strengthening and development. A flexible and adaptive mentoring approach allows to maintain a close relationship with the organization, respond to its real needs and provide support wherever it is needed.



ALUMNI CLUB

In 2018, we established the practice of post-training support and counseling for participants of our educational events. We realized immediately that this tool of organizational development is perhaps the most popular. Short online consultations and answers to the urgent questions of graduates of our Schools allow to achieve maximum effect in the shortest possible time.

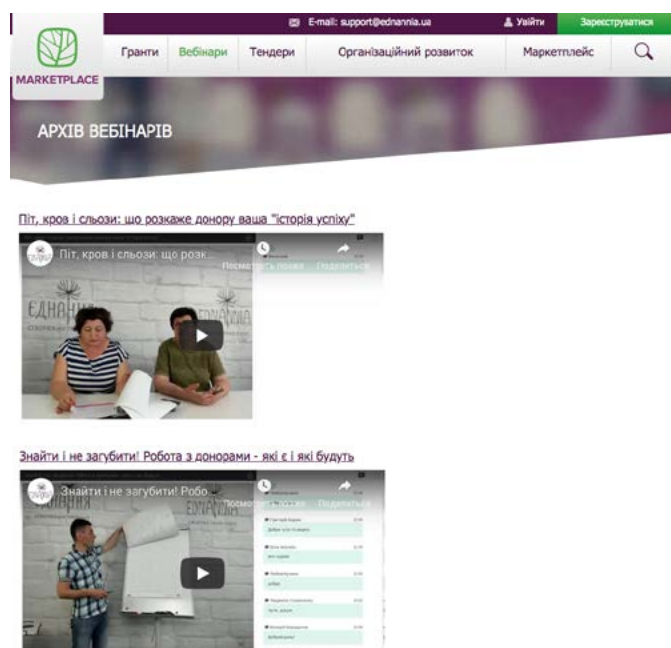

Trends in civil society development

The Annual Civil Society Capacity Development Forum is an event of the highest level for the nonprofit sector in Ukraine. Due to large-scale representation, it allows us to determine the main trends of civil society development for the next year.

These trends are the result of extensive analytical work: careful study of all public discussions; survey of representatives of non-governmental organizations; generalization of the content of reports; creation of a roadmap for the development of civil society for the next year. According to the Forum, in 2019 civil society organizations (CSOs) should develop in the following key areas:

01

Building trust, organizational sustainability and stability. Publication of reports about activities, separation of management (directors) and governance (board), transparent activity. Implementation of result-oriented management. Strategic approach to work, working towards change and influence. Development of financial sustainability by providing services to business and state.

Involvement of citizens in volunteering and activism, participation in decision-making processes and strategic philanthropy. Support and promotion of “grassroots” initiatives, helping citizens to unite for solution of common problems, especially at the local level. Creation of platforms for increasing social capital and support of “horizontal” ties.

Development of critical thinking. Persistent resistance to populism and awareness of our own responsibility for preserving freedom, implementation of reforms and creation of real democracy in Ukraine. Support for organizations and initiatives that work with the challenges of the electoral process, monitoring the observance of democratic procedures during the election.

Focus on social innovations which, in turn, demands the creation of democratic platforms for interaction between all sectors of society. Support for the process of fundamental transformation of economic, social and cultural agreements based on a new way of thinking that promotes sustainable development.

Self-organization. Investing in the development of civil society infrastructure as a way to achieve its sustainability and stability. Support for organizations that enhance the capacity of civic and charitable organizations, improve the legislative field, conduct research, develop leadership, help to communicate and disseminate information.

Strategic partnership with the private sector. Developing conditions for impact-investing and strengthening of our own capacity to implement measurable changes. Involving businesses in the decision making process at the local and national levels. Changing the paradigm of relationships: helping to implement a business mission instead of “sponsorship”.

Creation of the “agenda” of changes in the state. Advocacy of reforms. Strengthening of influence at all stages of cooperation with the authorities: from preparation of high-quality analytics and development of projects and necessary regulations – to lobbying, monitoring implementation and assistance in implementation.

Realization of national and local programs, including through financing of activities from state foundations, state and local budgets, budgets of united territorial communities. Strengthening project management skills and the ability to truly address local issues. Building capacity to provide social services while remaining a reliable partner in solving social problems.

Strengthening inter-organizational and cross-sectoral coordination of efforts and practical partnership. Exchange of results of projects, open access to data obtained during their implementation. Elaboration of common development strategies for sequential interventions, devoid of internal contradictions.

Development of capacity to counteract misinformation and other manifestations of hybrid warfare. Overcoming the causes and consequences of the conflict in eastern Ukraine, promoting the integration of IDPs in new communities. Mastering practices of dialogue and non-violent communication. Increasing the potential of using “cultural diplomacy”, especially on the international level. Development of strategies for the reintegration of temporarily occupied territories.

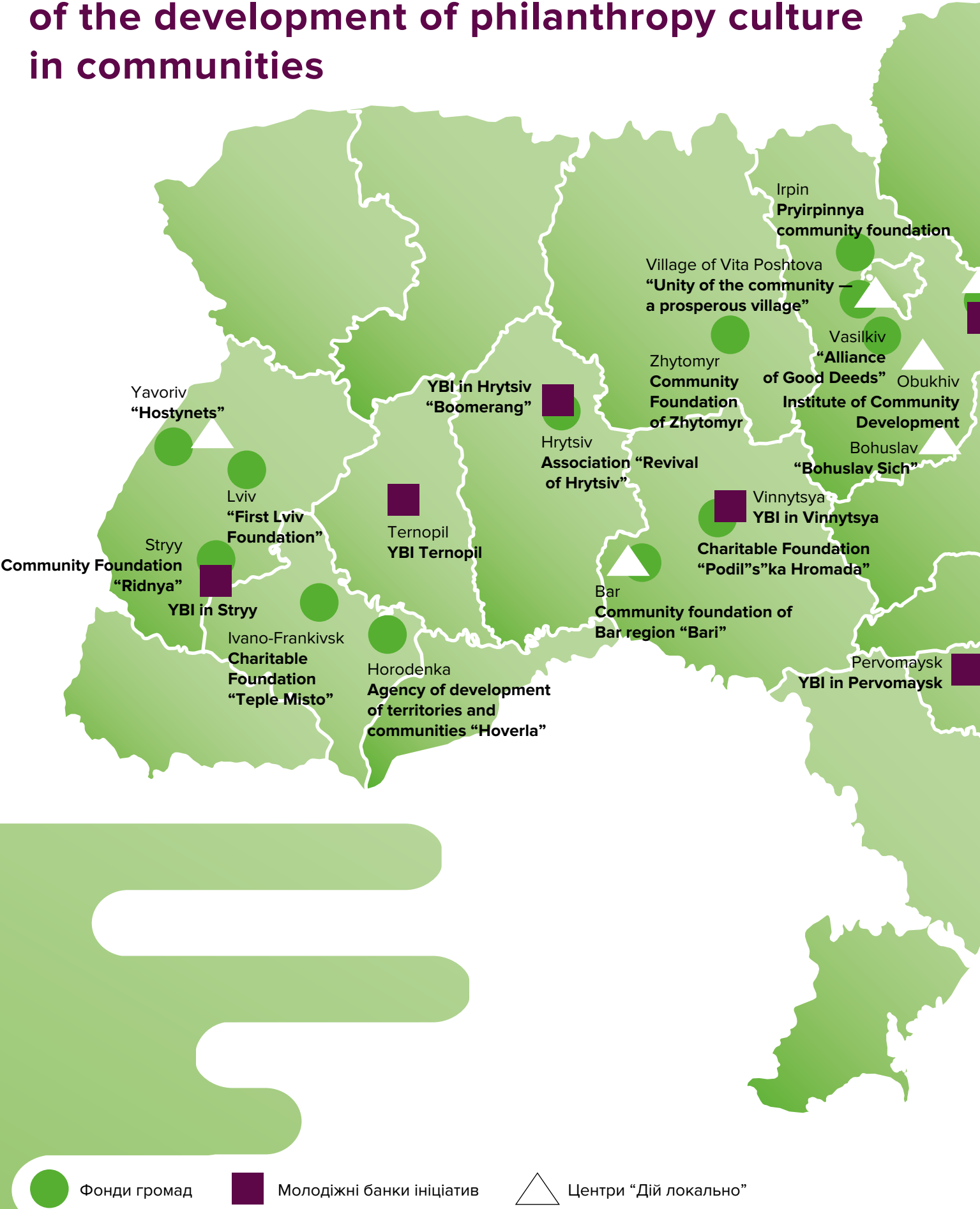


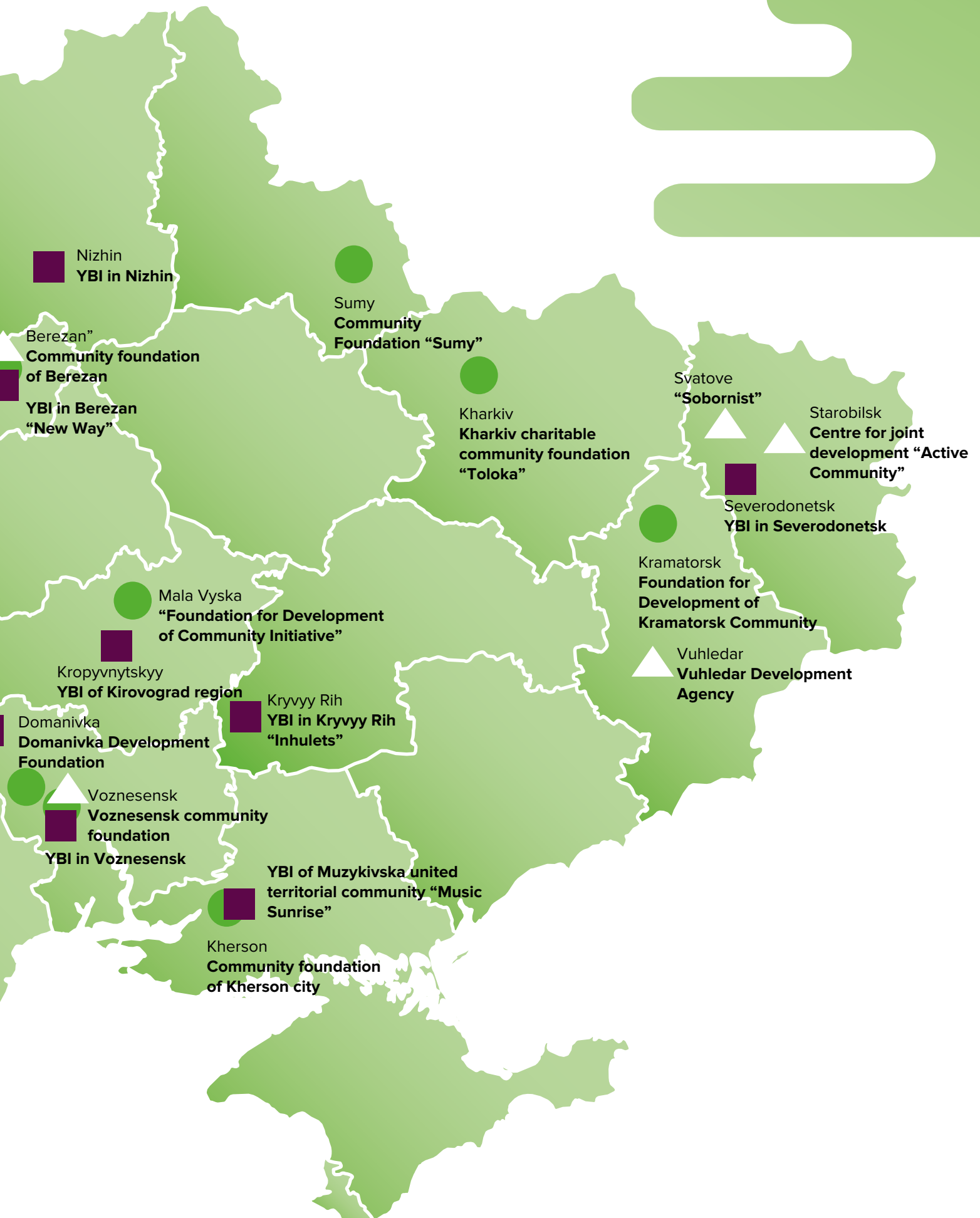

Community foundations define the needs of their community and attract funds from predominantly local resources. Community foundations use these funds to provide grants to local initiatives to address socially important local issues.

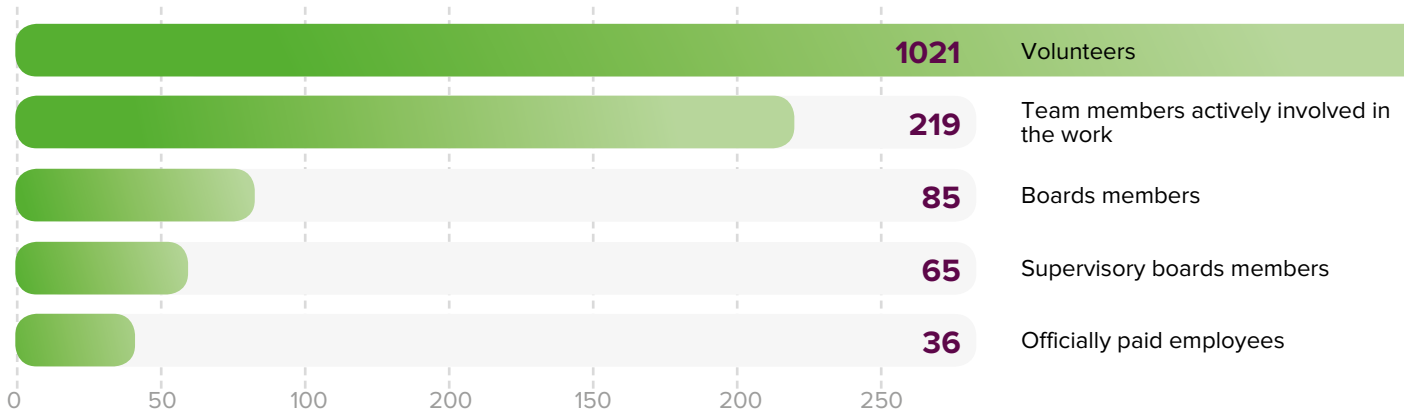


Community foundations are effective platforms for establishing of good communication and cooperation across all sectors of the community: local authorities, businesses and community members.

Programme “School of community foundations” has been a powerful tool for our work in the field of strategic philanthropy. During this time, we have become a leader in advancing the idea and development of the movement of community foundations in Ukraine. We have brought together leading Ukrainian experts and practitioners in community development and philanthropy, which meet regularly to discuss general issues related to the activities of community foundations in Ukraine and other countries, and jointly develop methodological recommendations for already functioning and newly created community foundations.



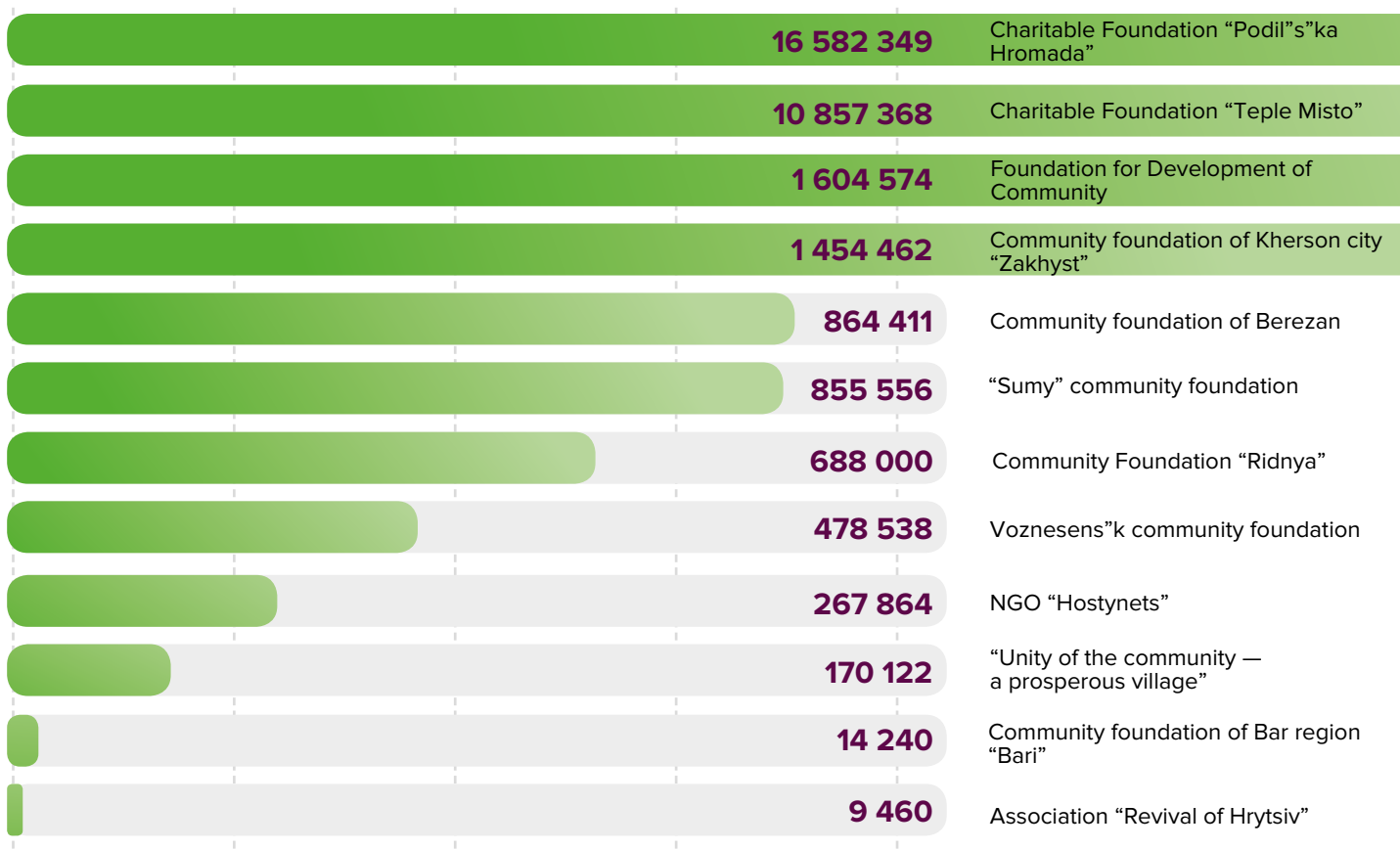
Total number of people involved in activities of community foundations in Ukraine, persons:

Investitions of community foundations in development of their communities (budgets of the corresponding programs), UAH

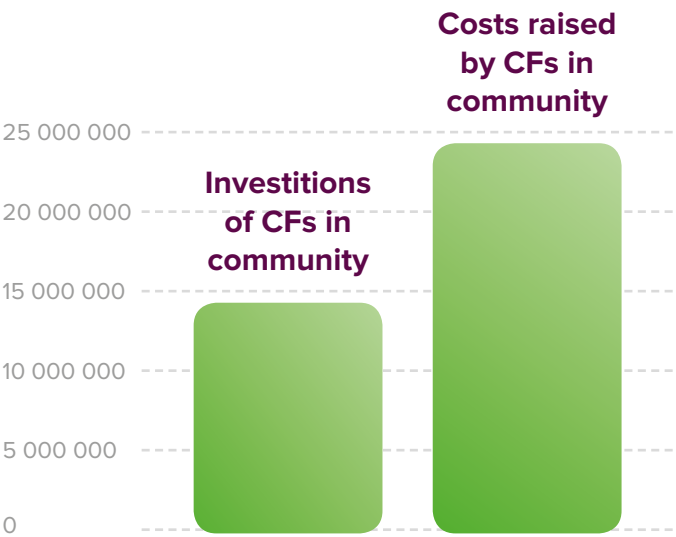

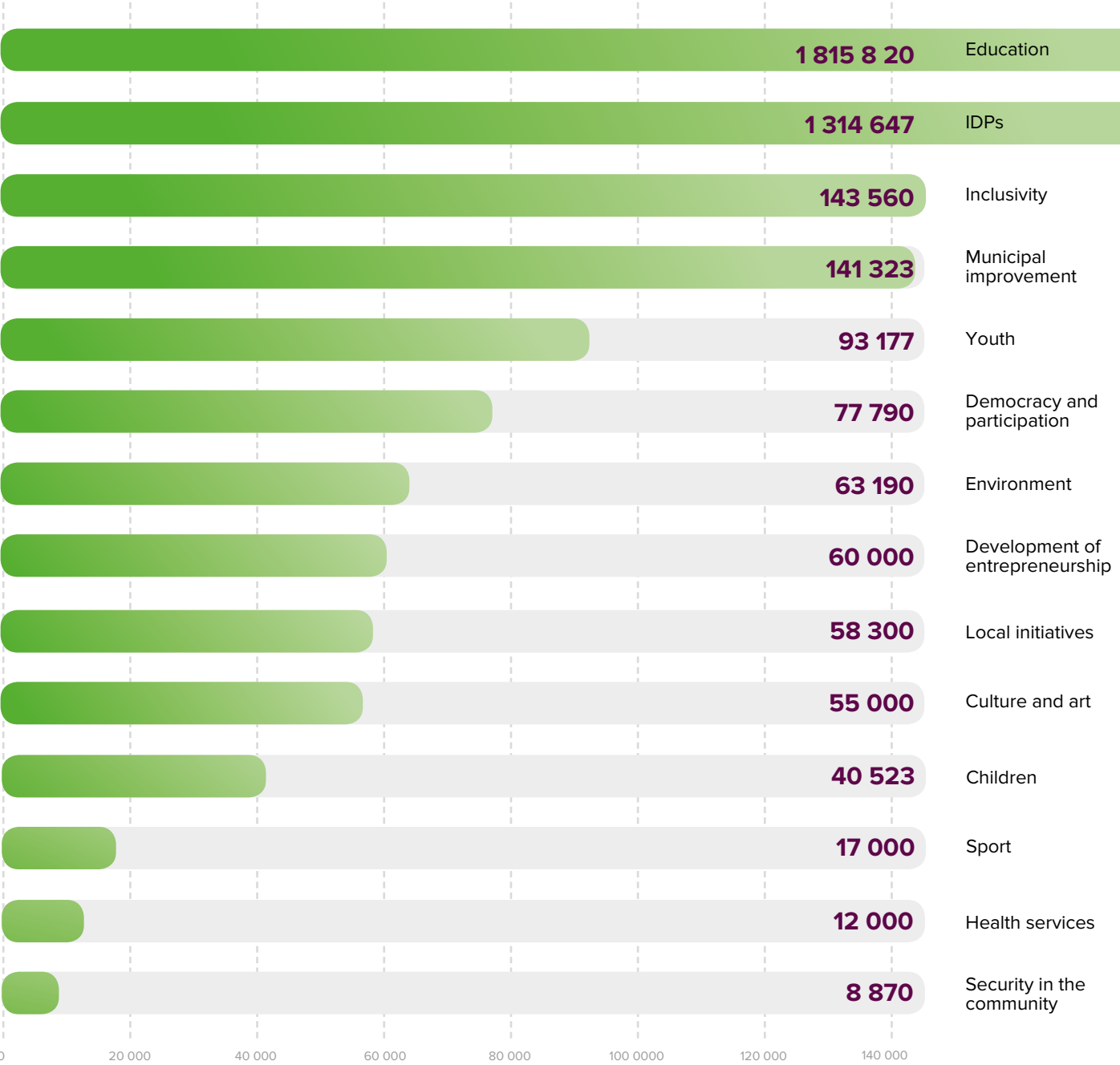

Grants issued by community foundations in 2018, by spheres (UAH):

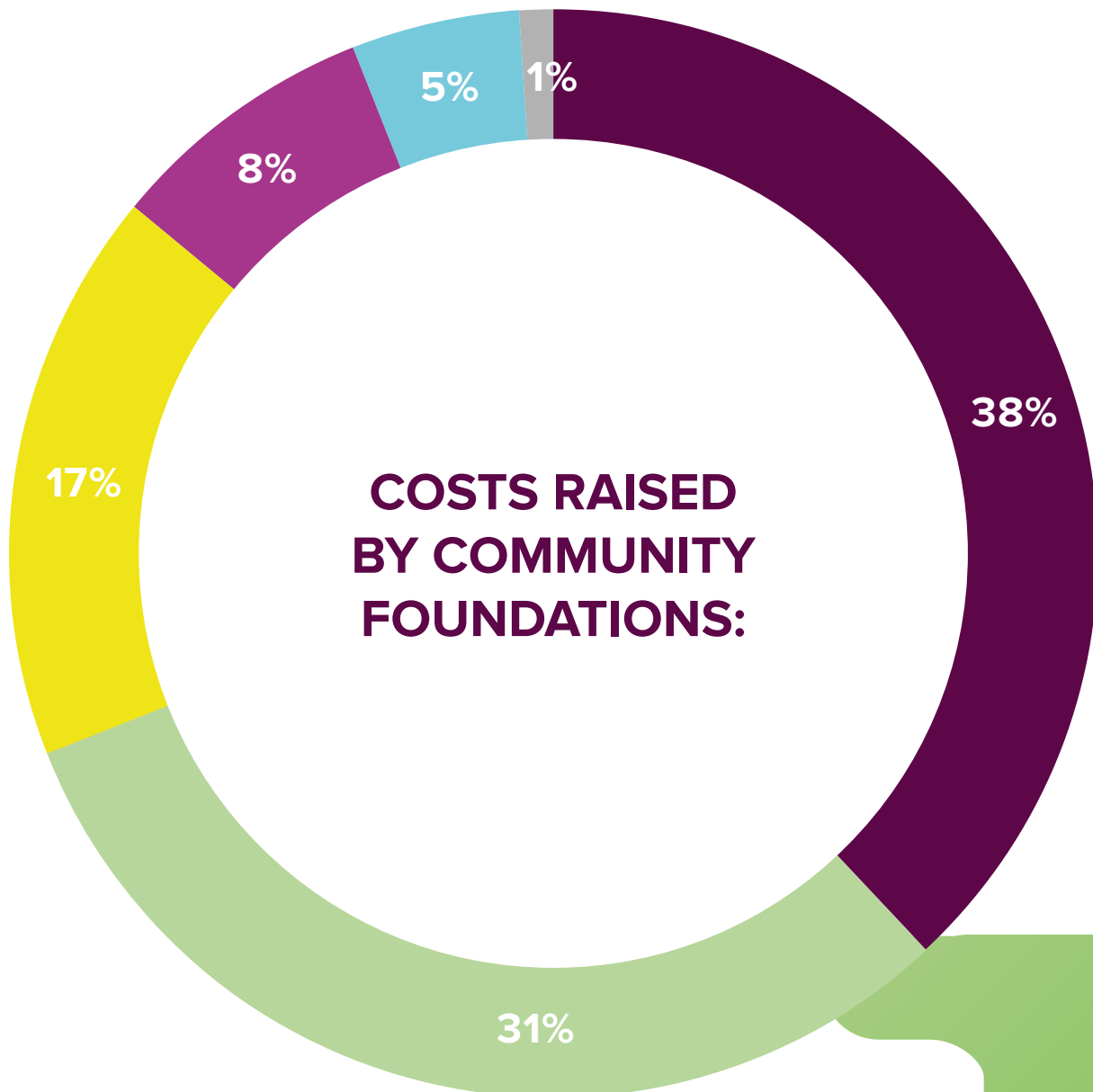

Kramatorsk CSO “Foundation for Development of Community”

Communication platform “Prostir” (Rivne)



The “Flying City” is the first Ukrainian mural that was not only painted on the wall, but also has a digital visualization. For the picture on the nine-story building to become “alive” one needs to download an application developed for the iOS and Android platforms. Next, one needs to point the camera of a smartphone or tablet at the mural and enjoy the technology of the augmented reality.

It will attract tourists who appreciate contemporary street art, they will take photos here and share them with friends through social networks. This will help to make city more popular!



THE FIRST YOUTH FORUM OF THE STRYY REGION

Community foundation “Ridnya”

The first youth forum of the Stryi region gathered several hundred participants. The forum was organized by the community foundation “Ridnya” and the School of leadership “Chance” with the assistance of the Lviv Oblast State Administration and the Stryi Regional State Administration. The youth forum lay foundations for a new youth policy in the Stryi region. During practical exercises and trainings on leadership, goal-setting, team building, fundraising and volunteering, conducted by well-known speakers and trainers, young people learned to work in teams and implement their ideas.





REMEMBRANCE MEMORIAL

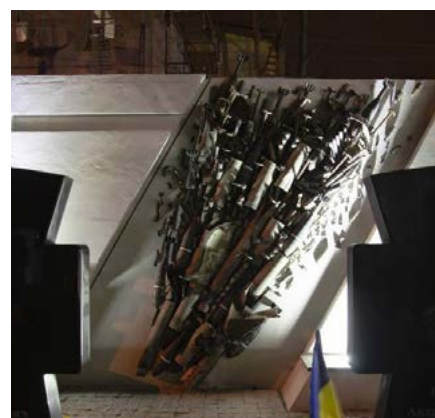
Community foundation "Sumy"

Construction of the Memorial to the killed ATO soldiers in the Central Cemetery of Sumy was completed. Works on this site lasted around three years.

In 2015 we came up with the idea to create a Memorial to ATO soldiers. At the same time we started receiving first inquiries from relatives of the killed who also had a similar wish. We discussed everything and appealed to the mayor of Sumy.

It took us long to gather the war metal for the Memorial. People were sending it to us from all over Ukraine, military personnel brought it from the East. It was extremely touching when people sent us small fragments that were symbolic for them. We received personal reminders of the war of many Ukrainians: pieces of armor, bullet shells. We used them all — from the largest to the very tiny.



NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH

“Unity of the community — a prosperous village”

“

Community foundation “Unity of the community — a prosperous village” (villages of Vita-Poshtova and Yuryivka of the Kyiv oblast) implemented the project “Neighborhood Watch” for the first time in rural Ukraine. During 10 months of duration of the project, the impetus was given to the creation of 8 groups of “Neighborhood Watches”. This means that more than 300 community members began to profess new values and a new lifestyle: they became responsible neighbors who care not only about their own security but also neighbor’s safety, working in partnership with each other and with the police. Participants of the “Neighborhood Watches” are people armed with knowledge of how to effectively protect themselves and their property — by coordinated communication with each other and the police in case of any danger.

BRITISH PARLIAMENTARY STYLE DEBATE IN VOZNESENSK

Voznesensk community foundation

The debates teaches to accept responsibility, not to be a passive observer. They give the opportunity not to store one’s thoughts “on a shelf” but to express them, subsequently implementing one’s wishes. And of course, this is a youth movement, where everyone will find true friends.

In 2018, the Voznesensk community foundation launched the “School Debate Tournaments” program for students attending 8–10 grades of secondary schools. Through the debate students will be able to master the skills of public speaking, analytical and critical thinking, learn to express their point of view in a structured and reasoned manner, get the opportunity to develop their leadership skills.

We have already set up 10 debate clubs attended regularly by 80 students and held 5 inter-school debating competitions where 50 students took part. We also held a city debating tournament. We have ambitious plans to promote the debate movement on the territory of the Mykolayiv oblast. We are going to pay special attention to attracting youth from the villages to the game and to the participation of our debaters in all-Ukrainian and international competitions.

A DROP OF BLOOD SAVES LIFE

Community foundation of Kherson city “Zakhyst”

Community foundation of Kherson city “Zakhyst” held a number of charitable events in the community to raise funds for the acquisition of a modern donor chair for the regional “Blood Services Center”. Significantly, the most prominent contribution to the project came from doctors who strongly feel the need for donor blood and understand the importance of developing blood donations. It was the doctors who initiated an extraordinary charitable event: they provided consultations to the patients on their day off, and transferred their fee for the day to the community foundation of Kherson city “Zakhyst”. The rest of the necessary sum was fundraised at the charitable party “Tango with Oleksandr Honobolin” (Oleksandr Honobolin is a People’s Artist of Ukraine, an honorary citizen of Kherson and a member of the Foundation’s Board).

When we were purchasing a donor chair, we were in for a pleasant surprise — involvement of people distant from Kherson. Upon having learned that the chair was purchased for charity donations of the Kherson citizens, the supplier from Kyiv made a contribution by giving a significant discount. We donated the chair to “Blood Services Center”. So from now on donors of blood – people who give a drop to themselves for the salvation of people often unknown to them – will have decent conditions!

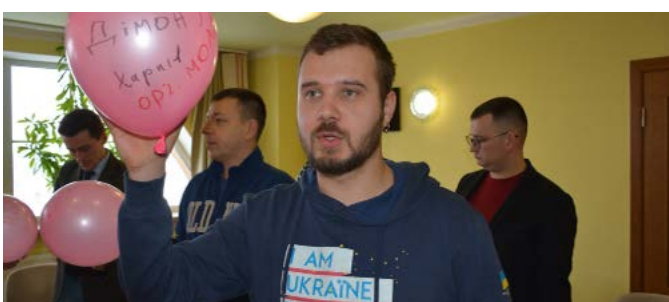

In 2018, another 10 organizations underwent comprehensive training about the work of the YBI as a part of the project “Distribution of the Model of Youth Banks Initiatives in Ukraine through the “Youth Worker” Program”, which was implemented by ISAR Ednannia in cooperation with the Ministry of Youth and Sports with the support of the UNDP Ukraine.

It consisted of two 3 day long offline workshops, 5 online modules on the Moodle platform, and a series of online experience-sharing sessions. This model of training has been successfully tested and will form the basis for a **Specialized training module on the work of YBI within the framework of the “Youth Worker” Program**, which will be attended by youth workers from different parts of Ukraine in future.





International cooperation

In November 2018, representatives of the Ukrainian YBI participated in an international conference in Istanbul, attended by 60 participants from 17 countries of Central and Eastern Europe. This meeting has become a space for sharing experiences and search for new opportunities for cooperation, as well as joint development of effective mechanisms for the development and popularization of the YBI model.



Local solutions to global challenges

We are implementing a project in cooperation with the Academy for the Development of Philanthropy in Poland, aimed at disseminating the positive experience of small communities in developing local philanthropy. Ukrainian nonprofit organizations working in this field have the opportunity to review the methodological recommendations developed by the Academy for the Development of Philanthropy for the “Act Locally” Centers in Poland. The program participants could also check how these recommendations work in practice during a study visit to Poland, which took place in 2016. In 2017 we continued this cooperation and supported a competition aimed at implementation of joint initiatives by Ukrainian and Polish organizations working to support of local initiatives.



SUMMER SCHOOL “ACT LOCALLY” IN WARSAW

In 2018, the work continued with the Summer School “Act Locally”, held in Warsaw. It was devoted to the presentation to representatives of the ten Ukrainian organizations of the “Act Locally” Programme in Poland. Participation in the School provided participants with knowledge about local fundraising tools, encouraged them to test these tools in their communities, and initiated a partnership between the Ukrainian and Polish “Act Locally” Centers.

Promotion of civic sector happening on this platform helps to convince stakeholders in Ukraine and beyond: Ukrainian civil society has competence, strength and inspiration to change the country for the better!

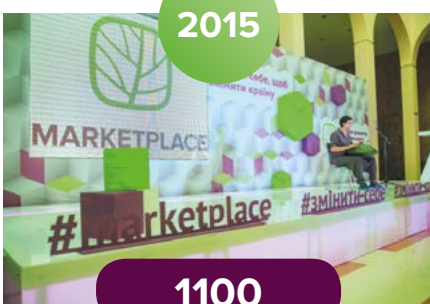

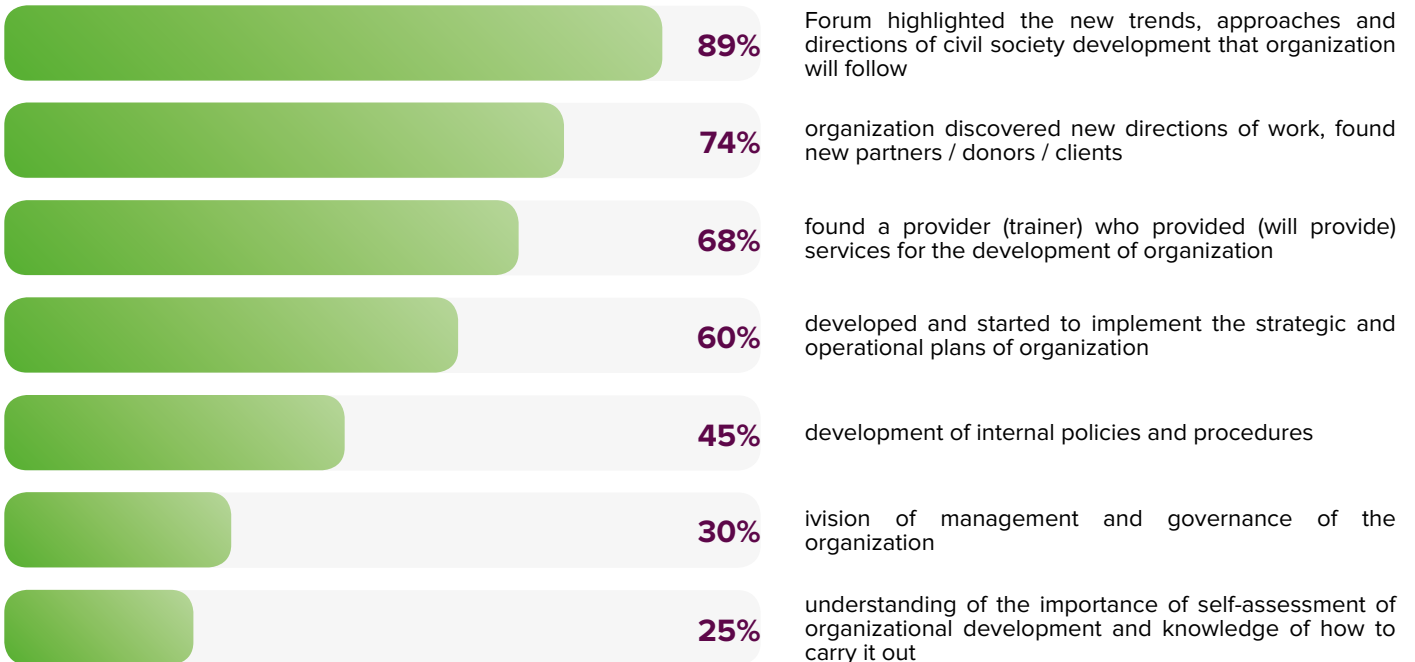

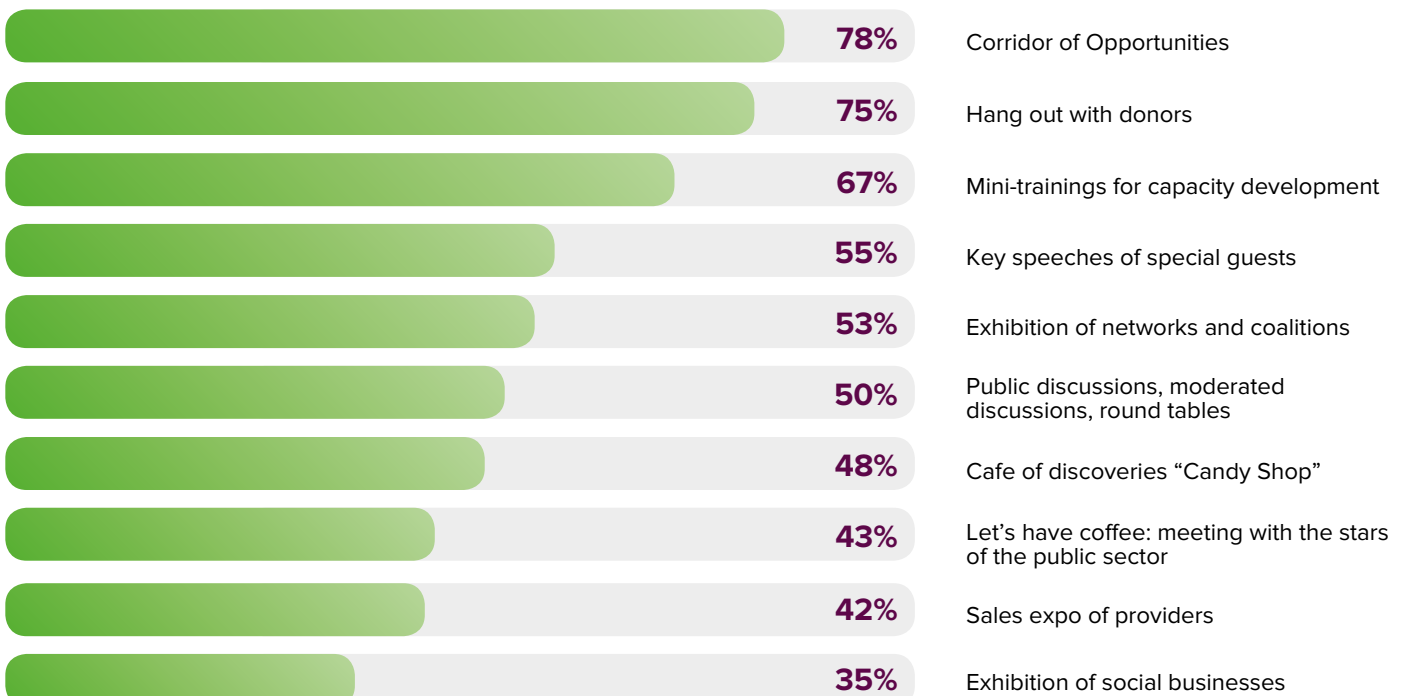


Special “Security Zone” at the Forum was a testimony of the importance of the issues of personal, organizational, media and legal security for civic organizations.

Strategic partnership with the Presidential Administration of Ukraine

The Administration of the President of Ukraine is the beneficiary of the project implemented by ISAR Ednannia with the support of the United States Agency for International Development. “Civil Society Development Platform” is aimed at strengthening the influence of civil society. Therefore, the interest of the Presidential Administration in the implementation of the project is evidence of understanding of the importance of the role that civic and charitable organizations should play in the course of Ukraine’s development.

ISAR Ednannia supports the work of the “Coordination council for the advancement of civil society development”. One of the main tasks of this Coordination council is to elaborate and submit proposals to the President of Ukraine regarding the establishment of constructive cooperation between state bodies, local government and civil society organizations. The executive director of ISAR Ednannia Volodymyr Sheygus joined the Coordinating Council at the invitation of the President of Ukraine, in order to contribute to the process of creating a supportive environment for strengthening the role of civil society, attracting the potential of non-governmental organizations to the processes of formation and implementation of state and regional policy and mechanisms for promoting the development of civil society in Ukraine.

Volodymyr Sheygus is also a member of the “Council on national unity”, created with the main task of making proposals to the President regarding the restoration of the historical memory of the Ukrainian people, strengthening the function of the state language, overcoming stereotypes and propaganda myths aimed at destroying unity, strengthening existing and establishing new interconnections between regions.

Meetings of community of practitioners

The community of practitioners is an informal platform for collecting, distributing and sharing information, ideas and best practices. Meetings of the community of practitioners differ from the usual meetings because of their ultimate focus on practical, realistic and clear result. Meetings of community of practitioners are held to discuss specific issues, to work out algorithms for their solution, to collect advice, to receive guidance. As a rule, participants of these meetings are people who have already solved such problems and have successful experience in this field.





Local platforms for dialogue and cooperation

ISAR Ednannia has a long tradition of developing local platforms for dialogue and cooperation between local stakeholders.

We invest in building an infrastructure for civil society, because we believe that it is necessary to achieve sustainable partnerships between businesses, local authorities and civil society.

Such platforms may arise as a continuation of work of a local non-profit organization that becomes a resource center for other local organizations. This way the Platform for interaction “Space” in Rivne, the NGO-HUB Civil Society Support Center in Vinnytsia or the “Intelligent Hub” in Sumy were created.

Another way is to hold regional forums, which we have been convening since 2015. In 2017, this experience took us to a new level of cooperation with the Kyiv city state administration — it commissioned us to organize the first Kyiv Forum of civil society organizations. In 2018, the second Kyiv Forum continued this tradition.

Kyiv Forum of civil society organizations

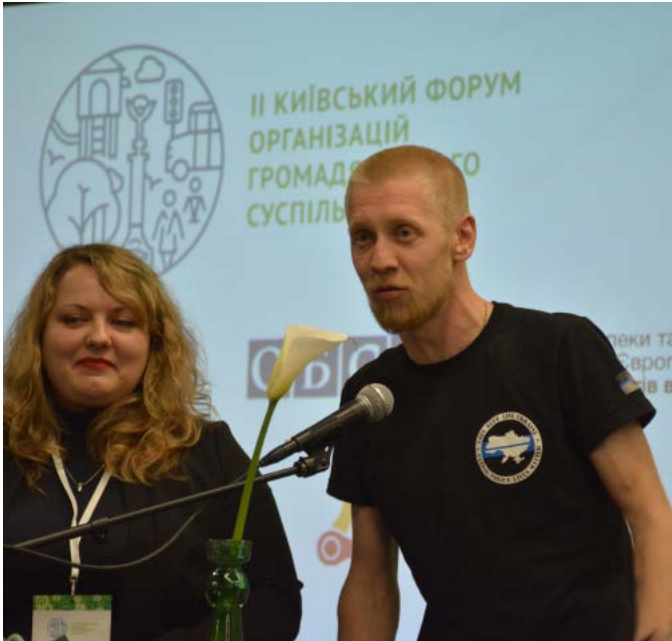
For the second year in a row, Kyiv Forum of civil society organizations has become an effective communication platform for establishing partner relations between Kyiv City Government and civil society organizations in implementing multi-sectoral projects and initiatives. 200 civil society organizations operating in the city of Kyiv for the benefit of the city community were selected as participants of the Forum.



The executive director of ISAR Ednannia Volodymyr Sheygus congratulated the Forum participants, since the event was held for the second time, which means that the idea of a platform where government, business and the public can share ideas and cooperate is apparently very timely:

DEVELOPMENT AND CONSOLIDATION OF DEMOCRACY

We believe that the real consolidation of democracy in Ukraine requires everyone's participation. We need unity of the community for building of a better state, for joint effort for the good of our homeland. Civic and charitable organizations that should help each citizen to feel their personal responsibility for the future. Consequently, it is not enough just to declare the need for democracy, we need to practice it every day, contributing to the common good of all Ukrainians.

We help to democratize the Ukrainian school, reform the local government and establish democratic cooperation between state authorities and CSOs. And we do this, believing that a successful Ukraine is possible only when each of its inhabitants will become a Citizen.

Improving the capacity of state and local authorities

Bodies of state and local authorities may conduct competitions of project aiming to solving local or national problems. Each year, the level of funding for grant competitions by the state is increasing, and consequently, the need for acquiring and improving skills for effective management and use of budget funds is increasing.





To improve the quality of these projects, as well as train officials how to organize and conduct grant competitions, we held 8 regional two-day training sessions in Ivano-Frankivsk, Lviv, Vinnitsa, Odesa, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Kramatorsk, and Kyiv with the support of the OSCE Project Co-ordinator in Ukraine. The concept of these trainings included the joint participation of representatives of state and local authorities and representatives of non-governmental organizations.

In 2017, the OSCE Project Co-ordinator in Ukraine prepared methodological guidelines for the development and management of projects funded by the state and implemented by CSOs. Consequently, the training program was built on the basis of the “Manual for Conducting Competitive Selection of CSO Projects for State Funding”, which includes both information on project management and on conducting project competitions: <http://bit.ly/2VqYInf>



Reform of school education

We must constantly learn and teach about democracy — every day, throughout our lives. No one is born to be a conscious citizen, we become them in the process of education and upbringing. At the same time, one of the biggest challenges of a modern school is the creation of a democratic environment for the education and upbringing of children based on the values of democracy and human rights. “The Democratic School: Supporting Educational Reforms in Ukraine” Programme launched in 2018 is a response to these challenges. It is implemented by the European Wergeland Centre with the support of the Norwegian Ministry of Foreign Affairs in cooperation with the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, the Council of Europe, the Center for Educational Initiatives,



In the Democratic School Programme, ISAR Ednannia is responsible for the creation and dissemination of online resources for the development of democratic competences.

In 2018, we launched the Programme’s website:
schools-for-democracy.org

Here each school can evaluate its level of openness and democracy, free of charge. They only need to use the

“School Democratic Development Tool”, which serves as the basis for self-assessment of schools, offering directions for further democratic development and helping to monitor the movement of the school towards the development of a culture of democracy.





In 2018, we launched the **online manual “Development of Civil Responsibility”**. The concept of Ukrainian school reform suggests fundamentally new approaches to the educational process, offering teachers the reorientation of attention to the formation of competencies of students, moving away from traditional methods of simple knowledge transfer. The online manual also provides support to teachers who will implement a cross-curricular “civic responsibility” theme in their subjects. It is **recommended for use in Ukrainian general secondary education institutions by the Ministry of Science and Education of Ukraine**.

To help trainers of the program to acquire specialized knowledge of civic education and school democratization, a course curriculum is available on the Programme’s website. Three volumes of “The Framework of Competences for a Culture of Democracy”, translated by ISAR Ednannia, can also be found here: <https://www.schools-for-democracy.org/biblioteka>

The participants were greeted by the Deputy Minister of Education and Science of Ukraine Roman Greba, the Deputy Minister of Youth and Sports of Ukraine Oleksandr Yarema, the Ambassador of Norway to Ukraine Ole T. Horpestad and the Executive Director of the European Wergeland Centre Ana Perona-Fjeldstad.

In particular, Ana Perona-Fjeldstad spoke about the development of online resources for the advancement of democratic values. Appropriate educational and training materials should be accessible to each participant of the educational process, and this is one of the objectives of the Democratic School Programme.



One of the most impressive parts of the conference was a fair of successful practices. Here school teams shared their stories of successful democratic change with colleagues and guests of the conference. The participants presented successful practices for the development of student self-government, improvement of the educational environment, development of cooperation with parents and community and introduction of civil competencies in the educational process.



Strengthening ties between police and community

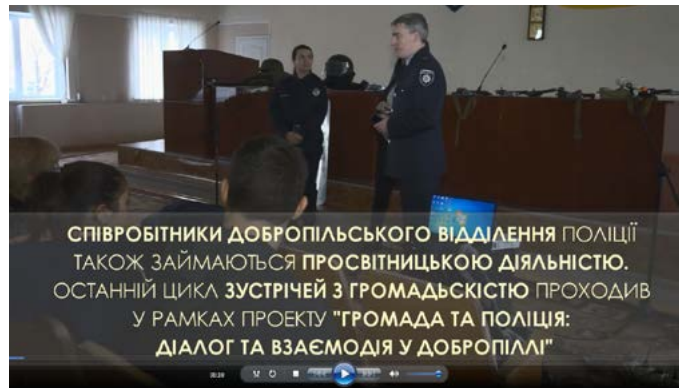
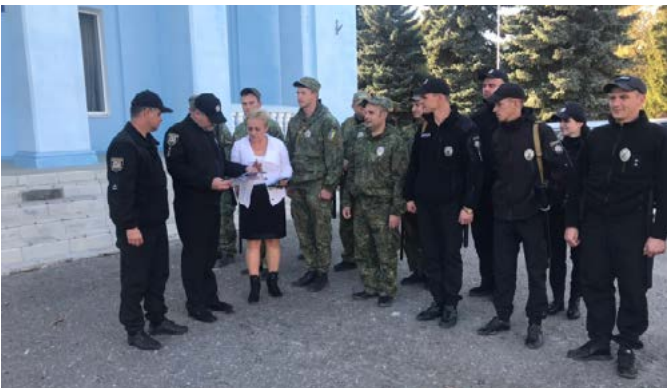
Since 2015, a new principle of community policing is being actively implemented by the Ukrainian Police. Community policing is a permanent, collaborative and proactive police and community cooperation aimed at meeting the security needs of the population. Joint efforts of community and police aimed at strengthening of security in the community, provide an opportunity to create a truly secure and protected environment, engage all community members in dialogue, and use resources rationally. In 2018, ISAR Ednannia in cooperation with the UNDP “Recovery and Peacebuilding” Programme conducted a grant competition aimed at strengthening personal and public security in the Donetsk, Lugansk and Zhytomyr regions through building trust and enhancing the interaction between the community and the police.

Implementation of BigData tools for managing public finances

In 2018, “Open Budgets” started working in Chernivtsi, Vinnytsya, Poltava and Zhytomyr. This process is a part of the project “Integrated Urban Development in Ukraine”, which is being implemented by Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH. ISAR Ednannia, as a member of a consortium of organizations responsible for strengthening the financial capacity of cities, carried out financial monitoring of the work of executive committees of city councils.

The financial capacity of cities is important because it is a criterion of decentralization of powers in the reform of local self-government. Consequently, Chernivtsi, Vinnytsya, Poltava and Zhytomyr, which joined the project, tested the concept of IT-based financial monitoring aimed at implementing the

goals of the monitoring system of integrated urban development as a progressive complex practice of transparency of the program-oriented budgeting in terms of its expenditures. Experience of Kyiv served as an example: here, “Open Budget” online platform was implemented as a progressive transparency tool.



Improvement of the budget process during decentralization

As a result of the intergovernmental fiscal reform launched in 2015, the resources of local budgets have increased significantly. From 2017, local budgets are obliged to move to a new system of program-oriented budgeting aimed at increasing the efficiency of the budget sphere through increased transparency of the budget. Yet there are still problems with the implementation of the system at the local level, resulting in ineffective realization of budgets.

In 2018, ISAR Ednannia launched the implementation of the project “Realization of the local budget in Donetsk and Luhansk oblasts”, aiming to improve the understanding of key stakeholders and enable them to address the problems of the budget process at the local level.

The project will continue in 2019: we will select and evaluate the budgets of the ten united territorial communities in terms of their efficiency, transparency and adaptability to the requirements of citizens. The results of evaluation, as well as recommendations for improving the budget process, will be made publicly available to stakeholders related to the communities participating in the project and the general public. As a result, we expect an improvement in the understanding of the reform of intergovernmental fiscal relations among local governments.



OUR INSTITUTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

In 2018, continuing our own traditions of constant self-improvement, we worked on the organizational development of ISAR Ednannia in the following key areas:

Revision of the Strategic Plan for 2018–2021

Strategic session is an opportunity for organization's employees to check if they are on the same page. After our work on revision of the strategic plan, everything is in sync in ISAR Ednannia: the values are affirmed, the mission statement has been perfected, the goals are realized, the plans are set. Forward and up!

Participation of staff in educational events and trainings

Olga Nikolskaya, manager of the direction “Development of the culture of philanthropic” took part in trainings for trainers and acquired knowledge and tools necessary for work with EU delegations and gender issues. Trainings for trainers was conducted by the European NGO Confederation for relief and development CONCORD (Brussels, Belgium)

Natalya Klymova, communications and organizational development manager, completed a short-term course “Communication in nonprofit organizations” at the UCU School of Journalism and “Crash course on community development” by ICA Associates Inc. (Canada).

Olena Hubar and Valentyna Dyomkina have studied the experience of the Academy of Philanthropy Development in Poland in creating and using the “Single Grant Database” for the Network of “Act Locally”, municipalities and other nonprofit organizations.

Alyona Graschenkova, financial manager, received the international certificate “Financial Manager for NGOs” from the International Association of Accounting Professionals (UK) and finished the course “Organizational development plan and improvement of internal policies in NGOs” run by the Audit and Consulting Group “Compass”.

Iryna Razumova, head accountant, participated in the international certification program “Financial management for NGOs” run by the International Association of Accounting Professionals (UK) and received the relevant certificate.

Strengthening the technical capacities of the grant system

Creating, testing and fully launching the online grant application system is a unique experience for Ukraine. From the beginning to the end it was made possible only because of the efforts of the ISAR Ednannia employees! The bonus – “Self-Assessment Tool for Organizational Development” is also available online. In 2018, we finalized the module for reviewing applications online by the Selection committee, so even the committee meetings are now happening on the Internet!

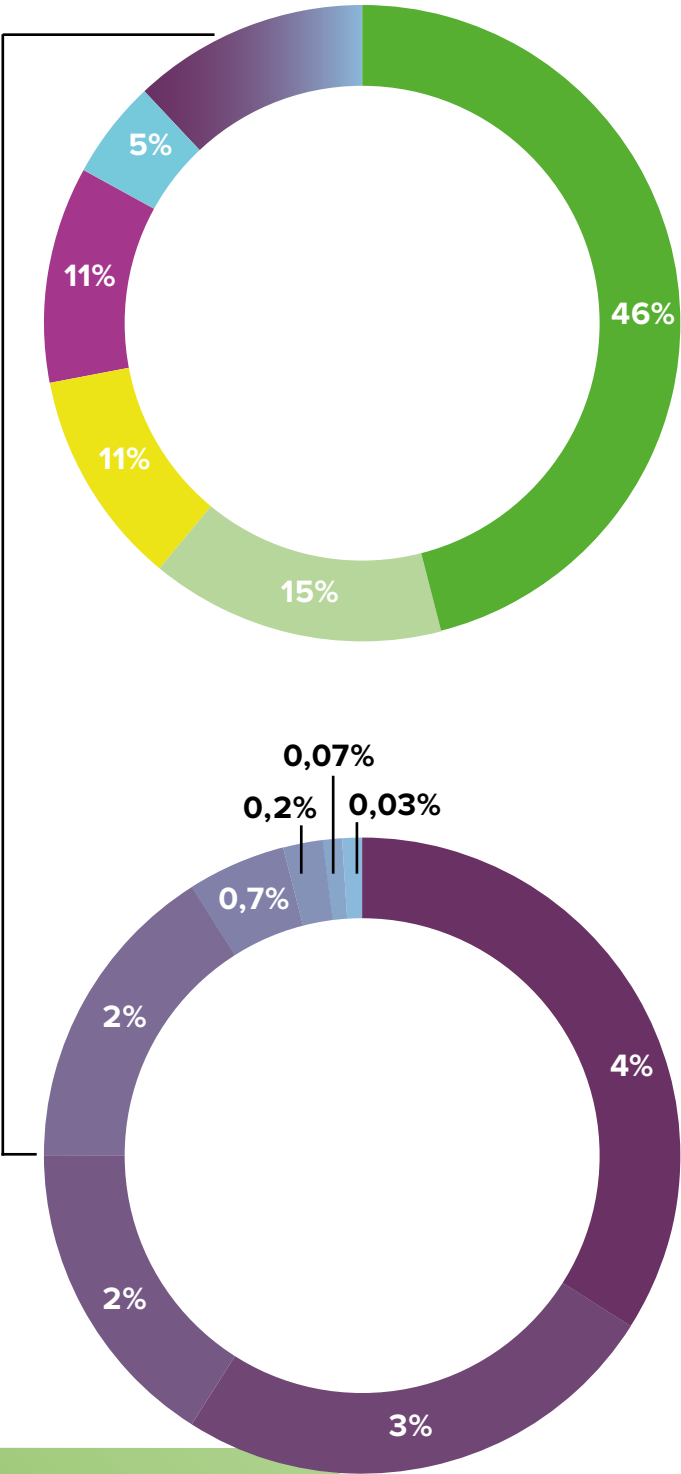

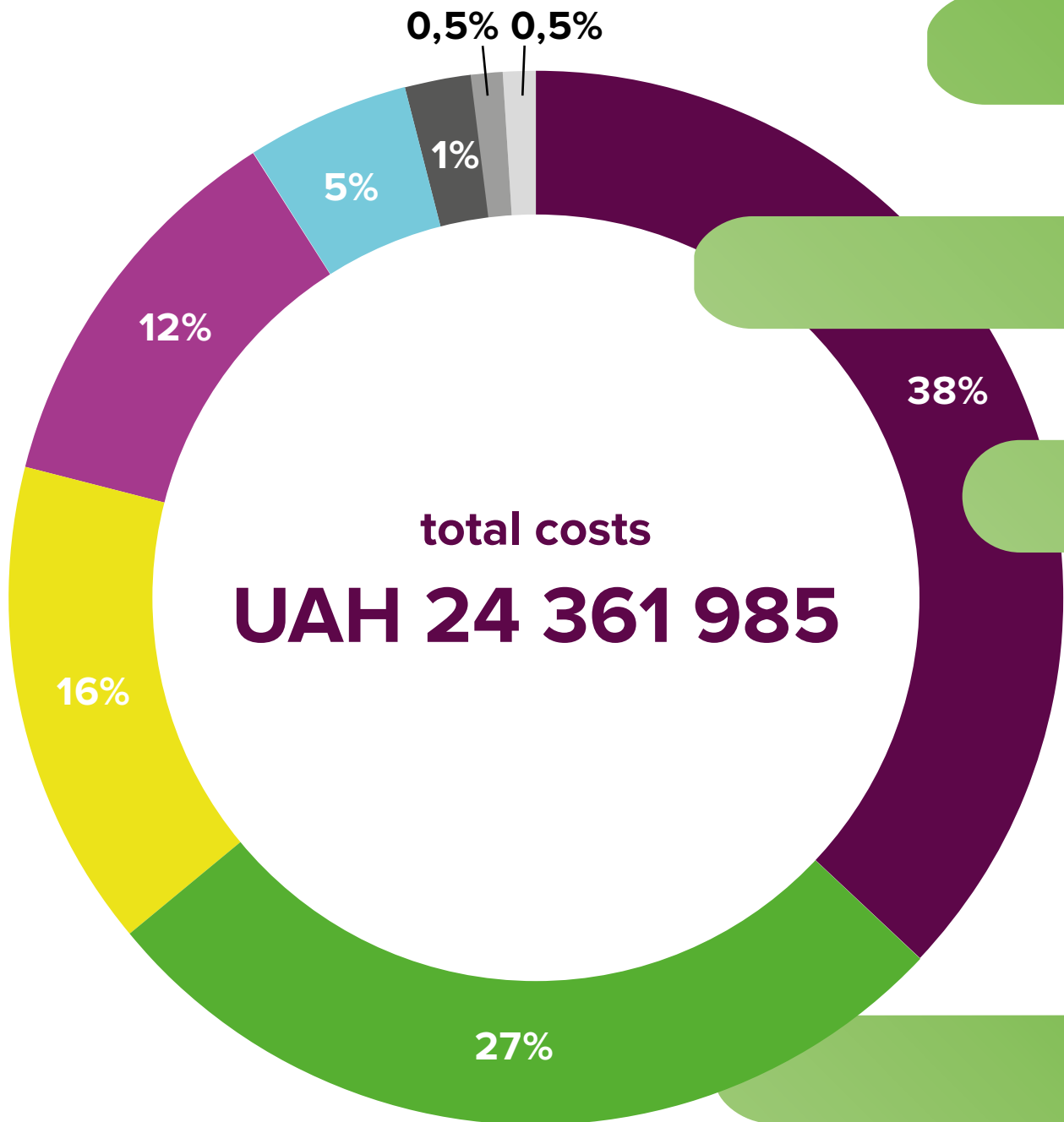
