ISAR Ednannia has the largest track record in administering small and large grants in Ukraine. Every year we provide financial support to 300-400 organizations from all oblasts of Ukraine. Annual independent audits confirm the full compliance of our grant procedures with international and national standards.

For 23 years, we have been developing the capacity of civil society in Ukraine. We apply a comprehensive approach to the development of non-profit organizations: microgrant support, training, mentoring, advisory support. In 2009 we created and have been developing since then a unique Civil Society Development Platform 'Marketplace', which has no analogues in the whole world: http://cd-platform.org. .....

The index of the sustainability of Ukrainian civic and charitable organizations has increased thanks to, among other things, our 'Marketplace' platform.

# **Our projects**

# **PROJECT 'CIVIL SOCIETY** SECTORAL SUPPORT ACTIVITY' (USAID)

Although Ukrainian civil society is unique in comparison with other post-Soviet social environments, it also faces some key challenges. One of the main challenges is the fact that the civil society must become fully self-reliant for the successful future of Ukraine. Self-reliance is the ability of an organization to take responsibility for its own existence, development, results of its performance, and interaction.

With the support of our long standing partner USAID, from 2019 to 2024, ISAR Ednannia in a consortium with the Ukrainian Center for Independent Political Research (UCIPR) and the Center for Democracy and Rule of Law (CEDEM) is implementing a large-scale project Civil Society Sectoral Support Initiative.

**Our goal in this project** is to improve the conditions of functioning for civil society and strengthen the institutional capacity of CSOs in order to increase the self-reliance of the civic sector in Ukraine.

- **1.** Internet portal a virtual platform that helps to meet supply and demand in the field of organizational development of CSOs. Here one can offer, search, order or choose trainings, consultations, research and other types of training or services that strengthen one's capacity. https://cd-platform.org/
- 2. Platforms for discussion of important issues in the field of organizational development: plans, strategies and policies; meetings of the Community of Practitioners, expert discussions, webinars. Civil Society Capacity Development Forum is the most anticipated event of the year!
- **3.** System of mini-grants for organizational development, which provides continuous financing of the market of services in the field of organizational capacity of CSOs. Any Ukrainian non-profit organization can apply to ISAR Ednannia to receive a grant for its own organizational or technical development. With the help of grants you can «purchase» the necessary services: training, seminar, short-term / long-term consultations, expert evaluation etc.

# Important events that happened in 2021 as part of the project 'Civil Society Sectoral Support Activity' (USAID)

.....

### The Regional Agenda of the Civil Society of Ukraine for 2022-2026 was developed.

This document is unique because it was developed by representatives of civil society and it is based on regional research. More than 800 people — employees, volunteers, members of governing bodies and experts from civic and charitable organizations participated in this process.

### A photo exhibition «Independence is me. Independence is us.

30 stories of changes to celebrate the anniversary of the restoration of independence» was organized to promote the role of civil society. The photo exhibition depicted 30 public initiatives as a symbol of the 30th anniversary of Ukraine's independence. Their selection was carried out based on the principle of covering the entire geography of the country and various fields of activity (ecology, education, support for people with disabilities, veterans, emigrants, care and assistance for children, the sphere of culture and sports, legal aid, etc.).



## Support with developing the National Strategy for a Barrier-Free Environment in Ukraine.

The Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine approved the National Strategy for a Barrier-Free Environment in Ukraine. It was developed as part of the initiative of First Lady Olena Zelenska and in accordance with the relevant decree of the President of Ukraine under the coordination of the Ministry of Regions. About 500 representatives of public, charitable, international organizations, state authorities, as well as experts and specialists of analytical centers and civil society organizations took part in online public discussions of the Strategy project. This work, as well as preparation of the summary of the public's proposals and analytical support for the process of strategy development, was led by a consortium of organizations consisting of ISAR Ednannia, the «Center for Economic Recovery» and the NGO «BarrierFree».









# *IPROJECT EU4CIVIL SOCIETY SUSTAINABILITY* **IN UKRAINE**



Since 2019, ISAR Ednannia is a strategic partner of the European Union. In 2021 Ednannia implemented the project EU4Civil Society Sustainability in Ukraine, within the European Union program Strategic Partnerships for Capacity Development of Civil Society Organisations in the Eastern Partnership.

**Our goal in this project** is to strengthen the resilience of civic and charitable organizations to challenges and emergencies, to help overcome possible negative impacts and to ensure the continuous implementation of their missions.

# What happened in 2021 in the framework of the project **EU4Civil Society Sustainability in Ukraine?**

## 1. Grant support for civil society organizations

- ISAR Ednannia provided support that was particularly relevant in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic, by offering **Core support grants** for organizations that became hopstages to the crisis and were affected by it, but had a vision how to hold on to their own position, remain focused, receive additional capacities and increase their influence in the sphere of their activity, despite the unpredictable environment. 8 SCOs received the general support. These were organizations that were increasing their influence, in particular, in advocating for children's rights, advocating and creating infrastructure to increase the accessibility of spaces for people with disabilities, promoting services for the created amalgamated territorial communitieshelping to develop local democracy and so on;
- 25 CSOs received Emergancy Support grants, which allowed them to strengthen their capacity to continue working despite the challenges and to provide services to more than 20,000 people their beneficiaries (people with disabilities, children, women survivors of violence, representatives of local communities, parents of newborns, parents with prematurely born children, the elderly, patients — i.e., groups of population in local communities that are most vulnerable to the pandemic);
- 10 CSOs raised funds for implementation of the ideas of their projects in their communities and received additional financing (Matching Grants) for realization of the projects aiming to solve the problems that their communities are facing.

## 2. NGO.Studio continued its work within the framework of the project. This is a media platform for discussion of topics of interest to civil society, exchange of ideas, experiences, and knowledge.

(lectures, seminars, webinars of providers of organizational development services, interviews with leaders of CSOs and current news in the sector)

NGO.Studio helped to demonstrate the achievements of various teams of organizations and civil society activists, their progress despite obstacles, examples of their mobilization and resilience despite the conditions of the restrictions of the COVID-19 pandemic.



3. 2 online tools were launched for the development of the organization's strategy and fundraising strategy. In the conditions of restrictions on movement and organization of the offline events, this opened the possibility for organizations to work independently on the development of their strategy. This also became a tool for organizing the remote work of the provider with CSOs on the development of their strategy.



## **COMMUNITY FOUNDATION SCHOOL (SUPPORTED** 2 **BY CHARLES STEWART MOTT FOUNDATION)**

The Community Foundation is a non-governmental structure that can be established in any village, amalgamated territorial community or large city to solve problems and achieve the goals of the local community. Back in 2010 ISAR Ednannia pioneered creating community foundations in the regions of Ukraine. Today there are more than 30 community foundations operational in the country. They bring together leaders and work with local authorities to improve the lives of community members.

In 2021, in connection with the extension of the project's duration, competitions were announced in January-April 2021. Community Foundations in Ukraine received 30 grants. Submitted applications were mainly aiming to acquire additional financing and development of cooperation with business; community foundations actively collected funds in their communities to prevent and fight the pandemic and meet other needs of the community.

In 2021, the activities of the Ukrainian Community Foundations continued under the influence of the pandemic restrictions of COVID-19, and subsequently their funding priorities were redirected to help hospitals and health workers in addition to their usual programs and projects.

# In 2021, ISAR Ednannia organized and held 2 schools: 'Raising Funds From Business' and 'Digitization for Community Foundations'.

The FundRaising School was conducted by the «Podilska Hromada» Foundation in Vinnytsia. The School's program included the following topics: Tools for working with business, Communication with business, Negotiations with business, practice and adaptation of fundraising tools.

Kherson community foundation «Zakhyst» held a School on digitalization of the work of foundations in Zaliznyi Port, Kherson oblast. It was a practical school aimed at developing the digital skills of community foundations. Invited expert skilfully combined theoretical and practical lessons, and at the end of the training, the participants mastered a variety of available online tools that facilitate the online work of community foundations. Sessions included: Google, Microsoft, Canva for NGOs, Microsoft Teams, Google Maps, tools for online work StreamYard, Melonapp, OBS Studio, ManyCam, how to create your own page, how to build a quality system for online education of staff etc.

7 Community Foundations participated in the project conducted by ISAR Ednannia in cooperation with the Austrian organization IZ — Verein zur Förderung von Vielfalt, Dialog und Bildung. During 9 months, they underwent training in a mixed model — online and offline training, as well as online training on ISAR Ednannia's platform (e-learninng.ednannia.ua). At the end of the project, small grants were awarded to those organizations that developed the best business plans during their participation in the project. The results of the grant competition were announced in February 2021. Berezan Community Foundation is among the 5 winners — their business plan for the full cycle of waste management was supported by the selection committee.

In 2021, 10 community foundations that submitted their half-year statistics raised over UAH 4,881,000 (\$180,000) locally and nearly UAH 7,740,000 (\$286,000) nationally and internationally. In addition, Vinnytsia Community Foundation «Podilska hromada» ensured transparent and accountable distribution of UAH 20,000,000 (\$ 740,000) of budget funds allocated by the Vinnytsia oblast council for the grant competition among local CSOs. As part of «Comfortable Communities» grant competition, 213 applications were received and 70 projects were supported.

During the first half of 2021, 5 Community Foundations held grant competitions in their communities. The total number of allocated grants is **128 for the total amount of** UAH 20,667,4147 (\$ 765,460). The distribution of grant funds was carried out in accordance with the policies and procedures developed by the Community Foundations with the assistance of the School of Community Foundations project. The number of allocated grants increased significantly, as Vinnytsia Community Foundation «Podilska hromada» distributed grants on behalf of Vinnytsia Oblast Council (20,000,000 UAH — 70 grants).

Ukrainian community foundations were invited to participate in European research initiated by various actors and aimed at studying the different approaches that community foundations have in Europe. For example, Italian scientists Gina Rossi from the University of Udine and Chiara Leardini from the University of Verona conducted a research project aimed at studying the impact of COVID-19 on the disclosure practices of Community Foundations in Europe.

# **ADMINISTRATION OF GRANTS** FINANCED BY UN RECOVERY AND

PEACEBUILDING PROGRAMME

In 2021 ISAR Ednannia with the support of UN Recovery and Peacebuilding Programme implemented project "Engaging an NGO/CSO as Responsible Party for managing small grants programme on the issues of community development and security initiatives, social cohesion, social integration, conflict prevention and peacebuilding, gender equality and gender-based violence prevention, community policing, promotion of participatory budgets, civil society peer-to-peer support programmes, CSO mentoring system, inter-municipal cooperation, support to women-led CSOs in the target hromadas of Donetsk, Luhansk, Zaporizhzhia, Kherson, Mykolaiv, Sumy and Chernihiv oblasts under ENI/2018/398-605, "EU Support to the East of Ukraine — Recovery, Peacebuilding and Governance", financed by the EU.

Within the framework of the project, 15 grant competitions were developed and conducted, the successful information campaign was carried out using information outlets for civic organizations and the «Marketplace» platform. System of Automated Grants Management (SAGMa)ISAR Ednannia allowed accepting applications online. This ensured openness and transparency while selecting best projects.

# ISAR Ednannia organized **10** webinars explaining the specifics of grant competitions, the procedure for

submitting project proposals, project management and reporting requirements, and successful communications of the organization.

**43,111\$** were additionally raised for the implementation of the projects. These funds were provided by local self-governments for additional financing of projects or funds that organizations collected through their own fundraising activities.

# What was accomplished within the projects:

installation of video surveillance cameras; purchase of firefighting equipment; arrangement of children's playgrounds and sports fields; work with children, including children with disabilities; development and publication of methodological materials on topics such as safety, work with children, etc.; preparation and implementation of security audits; arrangement of public spaces and outbuildings; installation of bicycle parkings; conducting trainings, work meetings; arrangement of HUBs; development of tourist routes; organization of a film festival; solving environmental problems through waste management, etc.









### "SCHOOLS FOR DEMOCRACY: SUPPORTING EDUCATION 5 **REFORMS IN UKRAINE" PROGRAMME**







Norwegian Ministry of Foreign Affairs

ISAR Ednannia implemented Schools for Democracy programme together with the European Wergeland Center, with the support of the Norwegian Ministry of Foreign Affairs in cooperation with the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, the Council of Europe, and the Center for Educational Initiatives.

Here are some of the goals of the Programme — support of the creation of new curricula aimed at the development of civic competencies; strengthening school autonomy; decentralization of school governance and democratization of the educational process; creating access to new online learning resources for the development of civic competencies; promotion of the professional development of teachers by strengthening capacity of regional institutes of postgraduate pedagogical education and relevant NGOs; maintaining a dialogue between educators from different regions; fostering development of educational policy.

In 2021 "Schools for Democracy" organized a series of online courses, including «30 Steps towards the New Ukrainian School: Teaching the Citizen» on the Prometheus platform.





# **«DEVELOPMENT OF COMMUNITIES IN UKRAINE THROUGH SOCIAL** ENTREPRENEURSHIP» PROGRAMME IN PARTNERSHIP WITH IZ — VIELFALT, DIALOG, BILDUNG (AUSTRIA)

# 1. Within the project, the online course "Social Entrepreneurship as a way for financial sustainability for CSOs" was elaborated and produced.

The course provides an opportunity to comprehensively explore the topic of Social Entrepreneurship and learn the experience of experts who in practice have gone through the process of starting a business and will continue to develop their business. This course focuses on the specifics of non-profit organizations and gives a deeper look at this topic. The uniqueness of the course is that it offers a tool for self-assessment. With its help, CSOs can assess the organization's ability to engage in Social Entrepreneurship.

# 2. Joint efforts within the School of Community Foundations (supported by the Ch.S. Mott Foundation) and in cooperation with the IZ - Verein zur Förderung von Vielfalt, Dialog und Bildung helped to involve 7 Community Foundations in training.

On the ISAR Ednannia educational platform (e-learning), Community Foundations spent 9 months training in a blended format. At the end of the project, the organizations that developed the best business plans for social entrepreneurship received small grants to start their projects.
