1	DOBRODAR	The project aims to establish a mobile social support service for 150 people with limited mobility, people with disabilities, and internally displaced persons in Pyatykhatky, Kyivskyi District of Kharkiv. The project will provide regular contact with beneficiaries, support in accessing government services, delivery of medicines and essential goods, as well as identification and referral of emergency cases. This will contribute to systematic and sustainable access to basic services for vulnerable groups amid military instability and limited mobility.	50923,13
2	Caritas Donetsk	The project aims to implement a systematic crisis support model in Dnipro for people arriving as part of evacuation flows from frontline areas. It will develop and implement a mechanism for initial needs assessment, rapid referral, and coordination among medical, social, and community-based services during the first critical days after arrival. This will improve the coordination of the response to the increased evacuation burden and ensure continuous access to support for the most vulnerable groups.	212075,13
3	Save Ukraine	The project aims to strengthen operational capacity to evacuate families with children, people with limited mobility, and people with disabilities from frontline areas of Ukraine amid the deteriorating security situation. The support will ensure the continuity of evacuation operations, improve their safety and efficiency, and expand the team's response capacity in Donetsk, Kherson, Zaporizhzhia, Kharkiv, and Dnipropetrovsk oblasts.	203858,40
4	Serhiy Prytula Charitable Foundation	The project aims to strengthen the organizational and educational capacity of the network's Civilian Readiness Center branches, which prepare the population to respond to wartime challenges. It will include developing a standardized operating model for the branches, security policies, and new training programs, as well as training instructors and regional teams. This will contribute to improving the quality and safety of training and strengthening communities' capacity to address modern security and information challenges.	208790,80

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5	Against Corruption	The project aims to ensure the uninterrupted operation of the Bereznehuvate Community Recovery Public Office and maintain residents' access to consultations and support in addressing challenges related to rebuilding their lives amid ongoing security risks. At least 300 community residents, including people returning after evacuation, will receive crisis navigation and assistance in accessing social, administrative, and humanitarian services. This will contribute to faster responses to community needs and strengthen community resilience.	129917,65
6	Is Harmony	The project aims to establish resilience hubs in border villages of the Horodnia community to provide residents with access to basic support and safe spaces amid military instability. Five village libraries will be equipped as autonomous support points with the necessary equipment to operate during emergencies. Facility staff and residents will also receive training in first aid, psychological first aid, and mine safety.	206550,60
7	Your hands helps	The project aims to restore and ensure the sustainable functioning of processes essential to the well-being and development of territorial communities in the field of social services, particularly the "Home Care" service. Particular attention will be paid to strengthening cooperation between civil society and local authorities to ensure the accessibility and adequate quality of social support for the population.	186997,81
